

C1 – Ceremonial Dress



COMPOSITION

- Tunic;
- Green Shirt w/Tie;
- Trousers or Kilt Order if issued; (Kilt, Plain brown sporran, lovat hose with flashings and oxfords)
- Parade Boots;
- Beret or Glengarry (Highlander and above);
- Red Sash; (Sgt and above)
- White Web Belt; (to be issued)
- Name Tag
- Medals, Wings and Pins
- White gloves (to be issued)
- Cadet Parka must be worn if issued and weather dictates

OCCASION OF WEAR

To be worn during formal parades, public events or other occasions as ordered.

C2 – Routine Training Dress



COMPOSITION

- Tunic w/Belt
- Green Shirt
- May be worn with or without the tie. If no tie, shirt collar will be outside and over tunic collar
- Pants
- Parade Boots
- Beret or Glengarry (Highlander and above);
- Red Sash (Sgt and above)
- Name Tag
- Undress ribbons, Wings and Pins.
- Cadet Parka must be worn if issued and weather dictates

OCCASION OF WEAR

To be worn as normal dress for duty, while travelling to and from a CTC or other occasions when ordered.

C2A– Routine Training Dress



COMPOSITION

Same as C-2 duty dress less tunic. Kilt order including white web belt may be worn as ordered.

To be worn on the shirt:

- Rank slip-ons
- Nametag
- Undress ribbons
- Pins and Wings

Undershirt, if worn, shall not be visible at the neck opening and at the sleeves.

OCCASION OF WEAR

To be worn as normal summer dress, while travelling to and from a CTC or other occasions when directed.

C5 – Field Training Uniform (FTU's)



COMPOSITION

- Olive-green trousers and shirt (sleeves may be rolled or shirt removed as ordered);
- Field Training Boots (aka combat boots);
- Issued green t-shirt;
- Beret or Glengarry (Highlander and above);
- Rank slip-ons;
- Bush Cap (Tilley) or tuque to be worn during FTX's; and
- Cadet Parka must be worn if issued and weather dictates.

OCCASION FOR WEAR

When taking part in activities where a requirement exists to protect the dress uniform or personal civilian clothing i.e. Corps/ FTX training or at a CTC.

C6 – Mess Dress



COMPOSITION

Same as C-1, except that a white collar dress shirt with black bow tie replaces the green shirt and tie. This is a highly optional order of dress and no cadet should be requested to acquire a white shirt and bow tie. If cadets do not possess a white shirt and bow tie, they can use the C-1 in the same circumstances.

OCCASION FOR WEAR

When cadets participate in formal dinners or other occasions as directed.
