The Birl



Due to the nature of the birl, there are three ways in which it can be played:

- the PUSH–PULL,
- the TAP-PULL, and
- the TAP-TAP.


PUSH and PULL both refer to a sliding motion of the pinky across the low A hole and TAP refers to a strike-like tapping of the low A hole. All three methods produce a similar result; however, the PUSH–PULL method is the most common and easiest to master.











Low G Doubling




